Paradox

Paradox, founded in Oslo in 1998, has produced over 30 projects including the Oscar shortlisted **The King's Choice** [2016], directed by Erik Poppe and starring Jesper Christensen [«Mr. White» in James Bond]. Notable productions by director Erik Poppe are Berlinale Competition nominee **U-July 22** [2018], and **A Thousand times Goodnight** [2013], starring Juliette Binoche.


Other Paradox productions worth mentioning are Berlin Competition Audience Award winner A Somewhat gentle Man [2011] and In Order of Disappearance [2014], both starring Stellan Skarsgård and directed by Hans Petter Moland - the latter remade in the US by StudioCanal as Cold Pursuit [2019], starring Liam Neeson. Paradox has also just released the HBO-series Welcome to Utmark to critical acclaims.

Paradox was acquired by the renowned SF Studios group [Swedish Ingmar Bergman producer] in 2018, with whom they co-produced Erik Poppe's latest feature **The Emigrants** portraying Scandinavians emigrating to the US in the late 1800s. Pre-production slate per now include the TV-series **In The Name of Love** and **The Commoner** for Nent/Viaplay, and **Quisling**, a theatrical film and also a series about the infamous Norwegian Second World War traitor's last days before his execution.





Mer Film's ambition is to produce, co-produce and distribute highend international films. Since it was established by producer Maria Ekerhovd in 2011, the company has grown to become one of the most dynamic and exciting production companies operating in the Nordics. Mer Film works with some of the finest European filmmakers working today, including the 2022 Academy Award® nominees Eskil Vogt and Jonas Poher Rasmussen. Mer Film's domestic distribution arm is an active part of the company's strategy to attract and inspire the conscious consumer.

International co-productions released include films by Wim Wenders, Amat Escalante and Carlos Reygadas in addition to Jonas Poher Rasmussen's triple Oscar® nominated animated documentary **Flee**. 



74 Entertainment

74 Entertainment is owned and run by producers Jørgen Storm Rosenberg and Kjetil Omberg. The company's business model is to produce both local content, including features and TV series, and international projects based on Scandinavian concepts.

74 Entertainment is a commercial company, and only develop projects they consider to have broad appeal. Rosenberg & Omberg have produced more than 35 features between them, sold more than 4,000,000 tickets, and participated in most A-festivals with their films – including The Bothersome Man at Cannes in 2006, and the Dead Snow-franchise at Sundance, 2009/2014.

Their last outing was the action-comedy **The Trip** with Noomi Rapace and Aksel Hennie helmed by Tommy Wirkola. The film opened locally in theathers in Norway to great attendance and fantastic reviews. The rest of the world enjoyed it at Netflix from October 15th 2021.

Storm Films

Storm Films was established in 1996, and shortly after the company produced the world's first CG- TV-series, **Two Wasted Wankers** at NRK followed by the feature **Free Jimmy**, starring Woody Harrelson and Jim Broadbent. **Free Jimmy** was selected for the Critic's Week in Cannes, won the Annecy Cristal and the National Amanda for the best feature. The Company also received an Academy Award for the co-production **Peter and the Wolf**.

The Company holds a strong position in Scandinavia and produces films for a broad audience. Captain Sabretooth [2014] was sold to more than 100 countries and was one of the highest-grossing Norwegian movies in 2014. It was followed by the Valley of the Knights [2015], the Netflix Original Battle [2018] and The Dragon Girl [2020]. In 2021, Storm released Three Wishes for Cinderella, becoming the 7th highest-grossing film in Norway all time, and Perfect Strangers, a remake of the italian box office success Perfetti Sconoscuiti.

Storm Films is a subsidiary of AAA rated STORM GROUP, consisting of VFX powerhouse STORM STUDIOS, Distributor EUFORIA FILM, and Scandinavia's biggest post house, NORDISK FILM SHORTCUT.

Fantefilm was established in 1997, making it one of the oldest production companies in Norway. Fantefilm aspires to produce larger than life movies for a wide-ranging cinema audience. 




